Question 1:

Attachment C indicates an Underwater Dive Inspection for P-13-0903. However, HSIS shows a dive inspection was completed on 10/18/2017 and did not indicate any other schedule for inspections. Therefore the next dive inspection would be due October of 2022. Please verify if a dive inspection is required in 2018.

Answer: This bridge is a box culvert that is submerged so cannot be inspected without diving.

Question 2:

Are initial & SIA inspections required for B-13-0856, B-13-0857, B-13- 0858? Or are these routine inspections? HSIS had no data other than plans for these bridges.

Answer: Yes, both initial and SIA inspections will be required for these bridges.

Question 3:

Are SIA and Fracture Critical inspections required for S-13-0619? HSIS had no data other than plans and construction history from 2009.

Answer: Yes, both initial and SIA inspections will be required for these bridges.

Question 4:

In Section 6 – Attachment D, is the column "WisDOT Pontis Element Course" referring to the "WisDOT Bridge Inspection Update Training" Course?

Answer: Yes. Please see and utilize the revised Attachment D below.
