The following responses are provided to questions received:

Question #1 *Is the current nursing staff associated with a union?*

Answer #1 No.

Question #2 *Does Dane County have a medical records software?*

Answer #2 Yes, the medical records software is provided by the current provider.

Question #3 *Is the nurse assigned to booking intake a RN?*

Answer #3 Yes.

Question #4 *How long does the booking assessment take?*

Answer #4 The assessment depends on a number of factors including medical history and if there are any significant medical issues. Generally 5 to 15 minutes.

Question #5 *Are there just large holding cells in Booking?*

Answer #5 No, there are side cells designated with cameras.

Question #6 *How many Female Housing Dorm beds are there?*

Answer #6 There are two dorms with 8 beds each.

Question #7 *How many beds are there in the large PSB PODS?*

Answer #7 There are 50 beds in each large PSB POD, plus two Time Out Rooms with one bed each.

Question #8 *Does the primary MD take any Mental Health calls?*

Answer #8 No, the Psychiatrist and Psychiatric RN take the calls.

Question #9 *Are sick calls placed through the kiosks?*

Answer #9 No, not at this time. Right now inmates fill out medical request slips and put them in locked boxes in their units. Dane County will have tablet or kiosk technology in all housing units in 6 months.

Question #10 *How many days of prescription medications are given to inmates upon their release?*

Answer #10 Typically 3 days, but if they need it for longer it is accommodated.

Question #11 *Where does medical staff park? How much are parking fees?*

Answer #11 Parking is available in the County Ramp for \$15 per month. The vendor will be invoiced. It is up to the vendor's discretion whether or not to charge their employees.

Question #12 *How long does med pass take?*

Answer #12 The times are averages for the CCB and PSB jails together. 1 ½ hours for 8am medication pass. 30 minutes for the 12pm medication pass. 1 ½ hours for the 8pm medication pass. 45 minutes for the 4am medication pass.

Question #13 How many med carts does Dane County have?

Answer #13 There are two in the PSB medical office and two assigned to the CCB medical office. All four are owned by our current vendor.

Question #14 How does Dane County handle patients who are detoxifying?

Answer #14 These inmates are housed in restrictive housing (segregation). Detox and area hospitals may be utilized as well.
